<b>Brief Description</b>	A seeding grant is available to new groups/organisations within the first 12 months of existence to assist with initial administrative expenses whilst they are establishing themselves.
<b>Programme Specific Criteria</b>	Groups/Organisations should identify how their activities will meet identified need and further address the themes and strategic actions outlined in the Fermanagh & Omagh District Council Corporate Plan.  To apply for a seeding grant groups/organisations must have an adopted constitution. Groups must also open a bank account to enable the transfer of funding through a Letter of Offer, if deemed eligible.
